



Senate District Executive Committee Meeting Notice

Texas Election code requires the state chair to call the first meeting of any District Executive Committee which is situated in more than one county.

Sec. 171.054. COMMITTEE COMPOSITION: DISTRICT SITUATED IN MORE THAN ONE COUNTY; FIRST MEETING. [..]

(b) The state chair shall call a meeting of the district executive committee to convene either as a whole in one location or separately in each county in the district at any time after the precinct chairs take office to fill a vacancy in a nomination or to transact any other business by the committee. The state chair shall notify the members of the district executive committee in advance of the time, place, and purpose of any meeting or meetings.[..]

To that end I have worked in conjunction with the Galveston county party to call this Senate District Executive Committee meeting at a time and place convenient for the county party and precinct chairs of Galveston county.

Monday, Oct. 11 at 7:30 p.m. or upon adjournment (whichever is later) of the County Executive Committee meeting at the Galveston County Annex. The purpose of this meeting is to elect a chair of the senate district executive committee.
